Peter and Nao Wei's daughter, Stephanie, won two individual titles and was part of two winning relay teams for Mitty in the West Catholic Athletic League finals. Her winning times in the individual events were league records.

On April 19 Ken Napier and 7 other senior citizens were inducted into the Bakersfield College track and field/cross country Hall of Fame. This was the 50th anniversary of the team's Southern California State junior college championship. The BC individuals finished 2nd (Miles Eisenman, 5th (Jerry Strong, 9th (Jim Wren), 10th (Ken Napier), and 13th (Vernon Crawford. They outscored Mt. San Antonio College 38-48. Jeff, who had run below par the last several weeks, had a very good day, averaging 4:27 per run. Jim Myers ran with us for the first time in 6 months, averaging 7:11 per mile pace for his runs. Tom Warfel averaged 7:16 per mile a few weeks ago when we ran repeat miles and improved all of the way down to 6:44 pace this morning.
