The top finisher in each division for each event receives 25 points, the second finisher receives 24 points, etc. Since you can only use your best 8 performances, the maximum score is 200 points (8 x 25). Grand Prix races included in the events count double. You must compete in at least 7 different events in order to be eligible for an award. The standings to date for 2009 for all who have scored in five or more races are as shown below. The first number shown in parenthesis is the number of races scored, including the double-scored races. The 2nd number is the total number of events competed in.
